Parkinson's Awareness Month

WHEREAS Parkinson's affects approximately 17,500 adults in the Province of British Columbia; and

WHEREAS Parkinson's Society of British Columbia is providing information, consultation, support services and education seminars for people with Parkinson's and their families; and is promoting a better understanding of this disorder; and

WHEREAS it is desirable to increase the level of understanding of Parkinson's and the needs of persons living with Parkinson's

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that I, Brenda Locke, do hereby proclaim April 2024, as "Parkinson's Awareness Month" in the City of Surrey.
