SUBJECT: 2020 ENGINEERING WATER METER AND SERVICE CONNECTION DESIGN CRITERIA MANUAL

The City of Surrey has updated its Water Meter Design Criteria Manual. These changes will allow us to continue to meet the needs of the City relative to infrastructure servicing, maintenance, and operations.

The updated document, along with a tabular list of amendments, are available at <http://www.surrey.ca/city-services/802.aspx>.

Key changes made in this update include:

- Clarification on the domestic water service connection sizing methodology to ensure consistent application;
- Clarification on the fixtures (tees, reducers, valves) configuration options to allow flexible design solution; and
- General housekeeping items.

The updates shall apply to all Land Development projects if, prior to **June 19, 2020**:

- The 100% design/Service Agreement drawings have not been accepted; or
- The pre-construction meeting has not been held; or
- Any servicing agreement extension has not been returned.

The updates shall apply to all Design & Construction Capital Projects that have not submitted a 90% detail design by **June 19, 2020**:
