Before Council to propose a name change to Frank Hurt School Park.

The following comments were made:

- The delegation provided an overview of Devon Allaire-Bell's life and read impact statements regarding his untimely death.
- Prior to Devon's murder, Frank Hurt Park was viewed as unsafe and was largely taken over by drug addicts, homeless people and served as a hiding place for the men who murdered Devon.
- After Devon's death, a group of Community Volunteers named the '*Devon Allaire-Bell clean-up crew*' organized a clean-up campaign to restore the park.
- The delegation requested Council to consider officially changing the name of the park from Frank Hurt School Park to Devon Allaire-Bell Park as a tribute to Devon.
- The delegation noted when they met with Parks, Planning, and Culture, they were told there is a standard procedure employed for park naming, and the normal convention is to name the park after the attached school. The delegation provided 9 pages of emails in support of their request and referenced other schools within Surrey where parks are attached that bear a different name.
- The delegation agreed there should be a playground, and fitness circuit installed in the park but reiterated it should be officially renamed as Devon Allaire-Bell Park.

Mayor and Council thanked the Allaire-Bell family for the work they undertook in the park cleanup project and noted the park renaming request will go back to staff for a recommendation.
