The Council met pursuant to Section 333A(3) of the "Municipal Act" for the purpose of holding a hearing on "Bear Creek Park Miniature Railway Agreement Authorization By-law, 1948, No. 946"

Councillors Bishop, Johnston, Atchison and Kuhn and the Reeve were present.

Commissioner Bothwell of the Board of Park Commissioners and Mr. John G. Farmer, Secretary, Board of Park Commissioners were present.

Mr. P. Routledge was also present.

No other persons were present.

The meeting was called to order with Councillor Johnston in the Chair.

Mr. Routledge spoke to some length and explained his views on the matter and stated that after giving full consideration to the proposal he was not anxious to proceed with the undertaking.

He stated that he would require approximately 50 truckloads of gravel as ballast for the track as well as construction of Kennedy Road to give access to the site of the roundhouse.

After further discussion Mr. Routledge withdrew his request for an Agreement and it was decided to drop the matter.
