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Conditions of Permit

1. This permit is issued pursuant to *Surrey's Waterworks Regulations and Charges By-Law, 2007, No. 16337*
2. This permit may be revoked by either the Surrey Fire Department or the Surrey Engineering Department at any time.
3. The applicant accepts full responsibility for care of the hydrant and will pay for repairs of any damage whatsoever to the hydrant during the time this permit is in effect.
4. The applicant hereby releases, indemnifies and saves harmless the City, its elected and appointed officials, employees and agents from and against any liability, actions, causes of actions, claims, damages, expenses, costs, debts, demands or losses suffered or incurred by the City arising from the granting or existence of this permit.
5. If any damages to the hydrant or any abnormalities on the hydrant are noticed the applicant will notify Surrey Water Operations Hydrant Foreman immediately.
6. The applicant shall take water from the hydrant by operating the independent gate valve that the City attaches to the hydrant. This valve is NOT to be removed.
7. The applicant shall make every effort to conserve water by closing the independent gate valve after drawing the volume of water required.
8. City of Surrey Water Operations requires minimum 24 hours notice to attach and or remove the independent gate valve. Attachment will occur between 0800 and 1000 hours on the date of first use and removed between 1500 and 1630 hours on the date of last use.
9. If the applicant finishes use of the hydrant in advance of their end date contact Water Operations within 24 hours for removal of the independent gate valve. No refund will be provided for daily water rates not used.
10. The applicant shall NOT tamper, adjust, open or close any part of the fire hydrant.
11. During times of the year when freezing weather is possible this permit shall not be valid longer than one day. If damage occurs to the hydrant as the result of freezing water the applicant will pay all costs to repair the hydrant. During freezing weather conditions the backflow preventor must be removed after use.
12. The application fee is non-refundable.
13. The applicant shall pay current daily water rates based at the time of completing application
14. **Any damages, or misuse of the City's backflow preventer (BFP) or in the event the BFP is lost or stolen, the applicant will be charged \$700. The applicant will be refused any future permits until this fee is paid to the City of Surrey.**
15. The applicant must use an adaptor to suit the 2 1/2 " Vancouver Standard Fire hose Thread at the outlet of the Backflow Preventer. Removing parts or reconfiguring the backflow preventer is considered tampering with the water system, VOIDS THE PERMIT and is subject to charges for inspection and or repairs in addition to fines permitted under *Surrey's Water By-Law*.
16. The applicant will be fully responsible for the Backflow Preventer in their care.
