
Land Development Consultants are reminded that, according to the City of Surrey Design Criteria Manual, Section 3.5, Clause I regarding Water Service Connections, all connections 100mm in diameter and larger require a single check valve. This check valve is to be located within the City Right-of-Way, as per the attached Standard Supplementary Drawing W.2, Fireline/Domestic Service Connection Greater Than or Equal to 100mm.

Please review this requirement with your designers. Thank you.
