Every dog over the age of three months is required by the City of Surrey to have a licence. Any dog deemed dangerous requires a dog licence immediately.

The "Surrey Animal Responsibility Bylaw, 2017, No. 19105", and amendments also regulates that a maximum of three dogs are allowed on a residential lot in Surrey, unless a hobby kennel licence has been issued.

Licenses will expire on the 31st day of December in the calendar year in which the licence is issued. A renewal notice will be sent to you prior to the dog licence expiry date.
