INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTOR

Contractors are advised that Addendum No. 1 to RFQ 1220-040-2017-042 is hereby issued by the City. This addendum shall form part of the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. The following information is provided to answer questions raised by Contractors for the above named project, to the extent referenced and shall become a part thereof. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractor or any sub-contractor not being familiar with this addendum. This Addendum No. 1 contains two (2) pages in total.

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS:

Q1: Is there a revised cutting schedule?

A1: Baseline schedule is located in Section B-3 Time Schedule Section 10(c). Will be modified slightly to suit anticipated award date.

Q2: When will the contract be awarded?

A2: At this time the earliest anticipated award date possibly April 12, 2017. Contractor mobilization date will follow shortly after.

Q3: What is the cutting schedule for King George Boulevards?

A3: Similar schedule to detention ponds as time permits. A need to adjust a more aggressive schedule according to the seasonal growth pattern will be considered. (To be determined upon Award and monitored by successful contractor in addition to the COS).

Q4: Is hand string trimming required?

A4: Final quality of cutting should not be compromised. In order to have a level grass surface that butts up to sidewalk joint & curbs may be needed. We ask for the contractor expertise in deciding which method will be needed to produce aesthetic pleasing mow. Please note that in some areas mowing around tree wells shall be cautioned as to not damage the roots & any material surrounding the trees.
