WHEREAS the "Heritage Conservation Act" being Chapter 165 R.S.B.C., 1979, provides that the Council may, by By-law, designate a building, structure of land, in whole or in part, as a Municipal heritage site;	
AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the following land together with the building thereon be preserved and that the said land together with the building thereon be designated by the Council as a Municipal heritage site for such purpose for the education and enjoyment of present and future generations.	
THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, and in pursuance of the authority of Section 11 (11) Subsection One (1) of the "Heritage Conservation Act" ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:	
l. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Municipal Heritage Site—Designation By-law, 1993, No. 11809".	
2. The following described parcel of land, together with the buildings thereon, is hereby designated as a Municipal Heritage Site for the purpose of preserving evidence of the Municipality's history, culture and heritage for the education and enjoyment of present and future generations, namely:	
Parcel "B" (Plan with Fee Deposited No. 15329F), North West Quarter, Section 31, Township 8, New Westminster District.	

The Tynehead Hall, believed to be the second oldest community hall in Surrey, was built in 1907, on land donated by Thomas Bothwell in 1907. The building is closely associated with many of the early settlers to the area.
The building is a simple front gabled box with shed roof extension along the side and hipped roof entry vestibule, in a rural homestead style.
and all provisions of the "Heritage Conservation Act" being Chapter 165 R.S.B.C., 1979, ——shall apply to the said parcel of land from the date of the final adoption of this By-law.
