SUBJECT: Award of Contract No. 1720-005-21 Intersection Improvements Package #2

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Engineering Department recommends that Council:

- 1. Award Contract No. 1720-005-21 to Crown Contracting Ltd. in the amount of \$2,558,534.58 (including GST), for intersection improvements at various locations;
- 2. Set the expenditure authorization limit for Contract No. 1720-005-21 at \$2,560,000.00 (including GST and contingency); and
- 3. Authorize the General Manager, Engineering to execute Contract No. 1720-005-21.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction package related to this contract consists of installation of one new traffic signal and a roundabout at the locations listed in the following table, which are also illustrated on the map attached to this report as Appendix "I":

The contract permits construction from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, in compliance with the *Surrey Noise Control Bylaw*, 1982, No. 7044. The contract does not include an option for contractors to work 24-hours a day, seven days a week as the work is located within residential areas.

The contract work is expected to start in June 2022 and be completed by October 2022.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenders for the subject contract were opened on April 29, 2022, with the following results:

The Engineer's (McElhanney Ltd. and Aplin & Martin Consultant Ltd.) pre-tender estimate was \$2.3 million (including GST).

EVALUATION

The submissions were reviewed for accuracy and completeness. No errors were found. All submissions included the required 10% bid bond and were signed on the Tender Form.

The low bidder, Crown Contracting Ltd., has provided a Consent of Surety for a Performance Bond and a Labour & Materials Bond, and agreed to complete the work within 100 working days, as stipulated in the contract. Crown Contracting Ltd.'s past performance on similar work has been satisfactory. They have no outstanding legal claims against the City. While Crown Contracting Ltd.'s tender was above the Engineer's pre-tender estimate, their tender provides good value to the City. It is recommended that Crown Contracting Ltd. be awarded Contract No. 1720-005-21.

SUSTAINABILITY CONSIDERATIONS

The work of this contract will support the objectives of the City's Sustainability Charter 2.o. In particular, the project supports the Sustainability Charter 2.o theme of Infrastructure. Specifically, this project supports the following Desired Outcomes ("DOs") and Strategic Direction ("SD"):

- All Infrastructure DO1: City facilities and infrastructure systems are well managed, adaptable and long lasting, and are effectively integrated into regional systems;
- All Infrastructure SD1: Proactively manage community assets to maintain them over the long-term in a state of good repair; and
- Transportation DO14: Goods movement throughout the City is efficient, and minimizes environmental and community impacts.


FUNDING
