The Board of Police Commissioners met at the Municipal Hall, Cloverdale. The Chairman and all members being present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Magistrate H. Rose appeared before the Board re the matter of his salary. He stated that when he accepted the position at a salary of \$400⁰⁰ per year he thought he was to receive the Court costs as well.

It was pointed out by the Reeve that the Municipal Act did not allow the costs to be paid to a magistrate when he was paid a salary. Mr. Rose said he was willing to take \$80⁰⁰ per month without the costs.
