WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey has found it necessary to acquire the within described property for the purpose of a Statutory Right-of-Way;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 578 of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia, the City Council may by by-law establish a highway or any portion of a highway;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 578(3) of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia, the City Council may acquire property by expropriation and have free entry thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to Section 578(3) and subject to Division 4 of PART XII of the "Municipal Act" of the Province of British Columbia, the Council of the City of Surrey is hereby authorized to enter upon, expropriate, break up, take and enter into possession of and use for the purpose of a Statutory Right-of-Way, ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey in the Province of British Columbia and being:

All that Portion of Parcel "A" (Reference Plan 1337), North Half of the North West Quarter, Section 6, Township 8, New Westminster District shown as Statutory Right-of-Way as outlined in heavy bold line on a Reference Plan attached hereto and forming a part of this By-law as Schedule A, and containing .939 hectares.

(Portion of 5574 - 168 Street)

2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and seal all documents necessary and incidental to effect such expropriation.
