

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 13981

An Expropriation by-law for the purpose of acquiring lands for highway.  
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WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey has found it necessary to acquire the within described property for the purpose of highway;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 527 (1) of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 323 of the Province of British Columbia, the City Council may by by-law authorize the acquisition of lands for highway purposes including the establishment, widening, alteration, relocation or diversion of a highway or any portion of a highway;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 309 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323 as amended of the Province of British Columbia, the City Council may acquire property by expropriation and have free entry thereon;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to Section 309 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 323 of the Province of British Columbia, the Council of the City of Surrey hereby authorizes the expropriation of certain lands free and clear of all encumbrances for the purpose of highway being ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly described as:

Parcel Identifier: 006-190-014  
That portion of Lot 77 Section 30 Township 2 West New Westminster  
District Plan 47666 shown outlined on Reference Plan LMP45427  
containing 205 square metres.

(Portion of 8704 - 120 Street)

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 8704 - 120 Street Expropriation By-law, 2000, No. 13981".
  
3. This By-law comes in to full force and effect on the date of final adoption.
