

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 14741

An Expropriation by-law for the purpose of acquiring a Statutory Right-of-Way.

.....

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey has found it necessary to acquire the within described property for the purpose of Statutory Right-of-Way;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 176(1)(d) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 323, as amended, the City Council may acquire, hold, manage and dispose of land, improvements, personal property or other property, and any interest or right in or with respect to that property;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 309 of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, the City Council may, for the purpose of exercising or performing its powers, duties and functions, expropriate real property or works, or an interest in them, in accordance with the *Expropriation Act*, R.S.B.C., 1996, c.125, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to Section 309 of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 323, as amended, the Council of the City of Surrey hereby authorizes the expropriation of a Statutory Right-of-Way for the purpose public rights of passage with or without vehicles and for the construction, extension, alteration, replacement, repair, upgrading, installation, protection, clearing, maintenance, operation, carrying out, use and servicing of works associated therewith, in, over, upon and under ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly described as:

That portion of Lot 2 Except: Part Dedicated Road on Plan LMP54570 Section 35 Township 2 New Westminster District Plan 18244 (Parcel Identifier: 010-339-302) shown as Statutory Right-of-Way outlined on Statutory Right-of-Way Plan LMP54571 containing 27 square metres.

(Portion of 15280 Fraser Highway)

2. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and seal all documents necessary and incidental to effect such expropriation.

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 15280 Fraser Highway Expropriation By-law, 2002, No. 14741."

4. This By-law comes in to full force and effect on the date of final adoption.
