BY-LAW NO. 15092

An Expropriation by-law for acquiring lands for road purposes  
.....

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey has found it necessary to acquire the within described property for road purposes;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 176(1)(d) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 323, as amended, the City Council may acquire, hold, manage and dispose of land, improvements, personal property or other property, and any interest or right in or with respect to that property;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 309 of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, the City Council may, for the purpose of exercising or performing its powers, duties and functions, expropriate real property or works, or an interest in them, in accordance with the *Expropriation Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.125, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Pursuant to Section 309 of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 323, as amended, the Council of the City of Surrey hereby authorizes the expropriation of certain lands in fee simple for road purposes being ALL AND SINGULAR that certain parcel or tract of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey in the Province of British Columbia and more particularly described as:

That portion of Lot 86, Block 3, Section 36, Block 5 North, Range 3 West, New Westminster District Plan 529A (Parcel Identifier: 011-840-251) being 62.0 square metres and outlined on Reference Plan BCP6107A.

(Portion of 9727 – 120<sup>th</sup> Street)

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as “Portion of 9727 – 120<sup>th</sup> Street Expropriation By-law, 2003, No. 15092”.
3. This By-law comes in to full force and effect on the date of final adoption.

PASSED THREE READINGS on the 21st day of July, 2003.
