

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 11852

A by-law to authorize the purchase of  
lands required for Corporate purposes.

WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described are required for the purpose of the Corporation;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled,  
ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Corporation of the District of Surrey is hereby authorized to purchase from the owner or owners thereof respectively, the following lands, all in the Municipality of Surrey, Province of British Columbia:

District Lot 361 Group 2 Except: Firstly: Part (Plan with Fee Deposited 14310F), Secondly: Parcel "D"  
(Reference Plan 8285), New Westminster District

(5202 - 168 Street)

at or for the sum of One Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,700,000.00) plus tax adjustment and conveyancing costs.

2. Upon receipt of good and valid conveyance of said lands in favour of the Corporation, the Mayor and Treasurer are hereby authorized to pay to the owner or owners thereof out of Corporate funds the purchase price as hereinbefore mentioned.

3. Upon conveyance of the lands described in Section One (1) hereof to the Corporation, the same shall be and it is hereby declared to be set aside and used for Corporate purposes.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Land Purchase By-law, 1993, No. 11852."

PASSED THREE READINGS by the Municipal Council on the 25th day of May, 1993.
