CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 12099

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 574(1) of the "Municipal Act", being Chapter 290, R.S.B.C., the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law and has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to pay to the said Registered Owner the sum of Ten Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars (\$10,298.00) and to execute and deliver on behalf of The City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

Those portions of Road of Section 13, Block 5
North, Range 1 West, New Westminster District,
dedicated by Plan 1772 as shown within the heavy
bold outline and hatched on a By-law Plan
attached hereto, prepared by Dieter Soukup,
British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 15th day of
January, 1993 and containing Six Hundred
Seventy-Six (676) Square Metres (PCL "E"); and

(Portion of 110 Avenue and 168 Street)

Those portions of Road of Section 7, Township 9, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 1779 as shown within the bold outline and hatched on a By-law Plan attached hereto, prepared by Dieter Soukup, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 15th day of January, 1993 and containing Zero Decimal Two Four Five (0.245) Hectares (PCL "B") and Zero Decimal Two Zero Three (0.203) Hectares (PCL "A").

(Portion of 108 Avenue and Portion of 172 Street)

2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land and other assurance mentioned in Section 1 hereof, such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

All that portion of Parcel "D", Section 13, Block 5 North, Range 1 West, New Westminster District, Reference Plan 80727 as shown within heavy bold outline on a plan prepared by Dieter Soukup, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 15th day of January, 1993 and containing Zero Decimal One Eight Seven (0.187) Hectares (PCL "F");

(Portion of 16770 CNR Yard - Surge)

All of Parcel "E", Section 13, Block 5 North, Range 1 West, New Westminster District, Reference Plan 80727 as shown within heavy bold outline on a plan prepared by Dieter Soukup, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 15th day of January, 1993 and containing Three Hundred Twenty-Six (326) Square Metres (PCL "G"); and

(Portion of 16770 CNR Yard - Surge)

All that Portion of Parcel "G", Section 7, Township 9, New Westminster District, Reference Plan 80727 as shown within heavy bold outline on a plan prepared by Dieter Soukup, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 15th day of January, 1993 and containing One Decimal Seven Four (1.74) Hectares (PCL "C").

(Portion of 16770 CNR Yard - Surge)

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 172 Street/108 Avenue/168 Street/110 Avenue Road Exchange By-law, 1993, No. 12099."
