

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 12176

A by-law to authorize the purchase of
lands required for Corporate purposes.

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WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described are required for Corporate purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Surrey is hereby authorized to purchase from the owner or owners thereof respectively, the following lands, all in the City of Surrey, Province of British Columbia:

That portion of the North Half Lot 24, Section 18, Township 2, New Westminster District, Plan 1692 included in the new Lot A on a plan of subdivision prepared by Peter Mueller, B.C.L.S. on the 15th of November, 1993.

(Portion of 6925 - 128 Street)

at or for the sum of Two Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000.00) plus tax adjustment and conveyancing costs.

2. Upon receipt of good and valid conveyance of said lands in favour of the City, the Mayor and General Manager, Finance, are hereby authorized to pay to the owner or owners thereof out of Corporate funds the purchase price as hereinbefore mentioned.

3. Upon conveyance of the lands described in Section One (1) hereof to the City, the same shall be and it is hereby declared to be set aside and used for Corporate purposes.

4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Land Purchase By-law, 1994, No. 12176."
