CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 12449

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 574(1) of the "Municipal Act", being Chapter 290, R.S.B.C., the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

That portion of North West Quarter, Section 21, Township 1, shown dedicated road on Plan 8367, New Westminster District, as shown hatched on a By-law Plan attached hereto, prepared by D.J. Dyck, British Columbia Land Surveyor dated August 26, 1994, and containing Six Hundred and Three Decimal Eight (603.8) Square Metres;

(Portion of 32 Avenue)

That portion of North West Quarter, Section 21, Township 1, shown dedicated road on Plan 8367, New Westminster District, as shown hatched on a By-law Plan attached hereto, prepared by D.J. Dyck, British Columbia Land Surveyor dated August 26, 1994, and containing Four Hundred and Sixteen Decimal Eight (416.8) Square Metres; and

(Portion of 136 Street)

That portion of District Lot 157, Group 2, shown dedicated road on Plan 16397, New Westminster District, as shown hatched on a By-law Plan attached hereto, prepared by D.J. Dyck, British Columbia Land Surveyor dated August 26, 1994, and containing Sixty-Eight Decimal Four (68.4) Square Metres.

(Portion of 32 Avenue)

2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land mentioned in Section 1 hereof, the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand One Hundred Two Dollars (\$35,102.00), together with such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

All that part of Lot 77, North West Quarter, Section 21, Township 1, New Westminster District, Plan 66672 included within the heavy outline on a By-law Plan prepared by D.J. Dyck, British Columbia Land Surveyor dated August 26, 1994, and containing One Hundred Nine Decimal Five (109.5) Square Metres.

(Portion of 13616 - 32 Avenue)

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 32 Avenue Road Exchange By-law, 1994, No. 12449."
