CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 12450

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 574(1) of the "Municipal Act", being Chapter 290, R.S.B.C., the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

All that portion of Section 15, Block 5 North, Range 1 West, New Westminster District shown dedicated as road on Plan 2368 and shown hatched within the heavy bold outline on a Reference Plan attached hereto and prepared by B.J. OKE, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 12th day of April, 1994, containing 385.0 Square Metres.

(Portion of Lane lying West of 160 Street between 108 and 108A Avenues)

2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land mentioned in Section 1 hereof, the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000), together with such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

All that portion of Lot 10, Block 5, Section 15, Block 5 North, Range 1 West, New Westminster District, Plan 2368, shown hatched within the heavy bold outline on a Reference Plan attached hereto and prepared by B.J. OKE, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 12th day of April, 1994, containing 147.0 Square Metres;

(Portion of 10813 - 160 Street)

All that portion of Lot 11, Block 5, Section 15, Block 5 North, Range 1 West, New Westminster District, Plan 2368, shown hatched within the heavy bold outline on a Reference Plan attached hereto and prepared by B.J. OKE, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 12th day of April, 1994, containing 69.0 Square Metres; and

(Portion of 15979 - 108 Avenue)

All that portion of Lot 12, Block 5, Section 15, Block 5 North, Range 1 West, New Westminster District, Plan 2368, shown hatched within the heavy bold outline on a Reference Plan attached hereto and prepared by B.J. OKE, British Columbia Land Surveyor on the 12th day of April, 1994, containing 49.0 Square Metres;

(Portion of 15969 - 108 Avenue)

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 160 Street/108 Avenue Road Exchange By-law, 1994, No. 12450."
