CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 12620

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 574(1) of the "Municipal Act", being Chapter 290, R.S.B.C., the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

That portion of Road lying in Section 22, Township 1, New Westminster District dedicated by Plan 1642, shown hatched on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Peter M. Mueller, B.C.L.S. on March 13th, 1995 and containing Zero and Nine Hundred Twenty-Eight One-Thousandths (0.928) hectares.

(Portion of the Semiahmoo Trail north of 24 Avenue to the west side of 150 Street and portion of 150 Street) 2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land mentioned in Section 1 hereof, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), together with such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

That portion of Lot D (BE64644), Section 22, Township 1, New Westminster District, Plan 1642, shown outlined in heavy black line on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Peter M. Mueller, B.C.L.S. on March 13th, 1995 and containing Nineteen (19) square metres.

(Portion of 14850 - 28 Avenue)

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "150 Street/Semiahmoo Trail Road Exchange By-law, 1995, No. 12620."
