BY-LAW NO. 13041

A by-law to remove a public highway reservation from certain lands.  
.....

WHEREAS by City of Surrey Lands Purchase and Dedication By-law, 1956, No. 1444, the lands known and described as the South Thirty-Three (33') Feet of Lot "E" of District Lot One Hundred and Twenty-One (121), Group Two (2), Plan Nine Hundred and Eleven (911), New Westminster District (the "Lands") were reserved for use as a public highway;

AND WHEREAS it is intended to remove the public highway reservation from the Lands to permit the City of Surrey to sell the Lands;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled pursuant to Section 532 of the Municipal Act, R.S.B.C. 1979 Chapter 290 as amended ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The reservation of the Lands for use as a public highway is hereby removed.
2. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Public Highway Reservation Removal By-law, 1997, No. 13041."
