## CITY OF SURREY

## BY-LAW NO. 13522

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in
exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 535 of the *Municipal Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

That portion of road in Section 22, Township 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 8887 shown as Parcel A and hatched on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by John Onderwater, B.C.L.S., on July 15, 1998, and containing 753 square metres; and

(Portion of 28 Avenue)

That portion of road in Section 22, Township 1, New Westminster District, dedicated by Plan 1642 shown as Parcel B and hatched on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by John Onderwater, B.C.L.S., on July 15, 1998 and containing 1200 square metres.

(Portion of 28 Avenue)

2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land mentioned in Section 1 hereof, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), together with such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

That portion of Parcel Identifier: 006-275-753, Lot 31, Section 22, Township 1, New Westminster District, Plan 41868, shown as Parcel C and outlined in heavy black line on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by John Onderwater, B.C.L.S., on July 15, 1998, and containing 857 square metres; and

(Portion of 2760 - 150 Street)

That portion of Parcel Identifier: 006-275-761, Lot 32, Section 22, Township 1, New Westminster District, Plan 41868, shown as Parcel D and outlined in heavy black line on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by John Onderwater, B.C.L.S., on July 15, 1998, and containing 975 square metres.

(Portion of 15046 - 28 Avenue)

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 27A Avenue Road Exchange By-law, 1998, No. 13522."




