CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 14179

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in
exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 525(3) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

All those portions of road shown outlined by a heavy black line, hatched on a Reference Plan, attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by J.G. Cameron, B.C.L.S., on the 17th day of November, 2000 and more particularly described as follows:

All that part dedicated as road by Plan LMP21610, Section 28, Township 2 New Westminster District, containing 786 square metres and called Parcel "A"; and

(Portion of 136A Street)

All that part dedicated as road by Plan LMP21610, Section 28, Township 2 New Westminster District, containing 151 square metres and called Parcel "B".

(Portion of 136A Street)

2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land mentioned in Section 1 hereof, the sum of Thirty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Three Dollars (\$39,763.00), together with such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

All those portions of land shown within the heavy bold outline on Reference Plan, attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by J.G. Cameron, B.C.L.S., on the 17th day of November, 2000 and more particularly described as follows:

All that portion of Lot 2 Section 28 Township 2 New Westminster District Plan LMP21610, containing 26 square metres and called

Parcel "C";

(Portion of 13669 - 80 Avenue)

All that portion of Lot 2 Section 28 Township 2 New Westminster District Plan 70235, containing 11 square metres and called Parcel "D";

(Portion of 13677 - 80 Avenue)

All that portion of Lot "B" Section 28 Township 2 New Westminster District Plan 15356, containing 22 square metres and called Parcel "E"; and

(Portion of 13695 - 80 Avenue)

All that portion of Lot 6 Section 28 Township 2 New Westminster District Plan 14295, containing 43 square metres and called Parcel "F".
