CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 14688

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in
exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 525(3) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

Those portions of road lying in Section 9 Block 5 North Range 1 West, New Westminster District, shown dedicated as road on Plan 1718, shown hatched on a Reference Plan attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by H. David Liddle, B.C.L.S. on the 10th day of April, 2002, and more particularly described as follows:

Parcel "A", containing 0.123 hectares;

(Portion of 113 Avenue)

Parcel "B", containing 727 square metres; and

(Portion of 113 Avenue)

Parcel "D", containing 5 square metres.

(Portion of 154A Street)

2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land mentioned in Section 1 hereof, the sum of One hundred and forty-seven thousand, one hundred and fifty dollars (\$147,150.00), together with such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

Those portions of land shown in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by H. David Liddle, B.C.L.S. on the 10th day of April, 2002, and more particularly described as follows:

Portions of Parcel Identifier: 000-536-482 Block 6 Section 9 Block 5 North Range 1 West New Westminster District Plan 6011, containing 0.321 hectares and called Parcel "C" and containing 2 square metres and called Parcel "E"; and

(Portions of 11261 - 156 Street)

Portion of Parcel Identifier: 000-536-491 Block 7 Section 9 Block 5 North Range 1 West New Westminster District Plan 7410, containing 111 square metres and called Parcel "F".

(Portion of 11317 - 156 Street)

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portions of 113 Avenue and 154A Street Road Exchange By-law, 2002, No. 14688."
