CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 14716

A by-law to dispose of portions of a public highway in exchange for adjoining lands necessary for a public highway.

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 525(3) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, the Council may by by-law dispose of a portion of a highway in exchange for land necessary for the purpose of improving, widening, straightening, relocating or diverting a highway;

AND WHEREAS the Registered Owner of the land described in Section 2 of this By-law has agreed with the City of Surrey to make the exchange hereinafter provided for;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 Upon receiving from the said Registered Owner, the conveyance or other assurance mentioned in Section 2 hereof, the Mayor and the Clerk of the City of Surrey are hereby authorized, in exchange therefore, to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary for vesting in the said Registered Owner, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of land and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

> Those portions of road lying in Section 29 Township 2 New Westminster District, shown hatched on a Reference Plan attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Scott E. Netherton, B.C.L.S. on the 10th day of April, 2002, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road dedicated by Plan LMP49714, containing 0.149 hectares and called Parcel "D"; and

(Portion of 86 Avenue)

That portion of road dedicated by Plan LMP49715, containing 9 square metres and called Parcel "C"

(Portion of 86 Avenue)

2. For the purpose of acquiring adjacent lands for a public highway, the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to accept from the said Registered Owner, in exchange for the land mentioned in Section 1 hereof, the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), together with such conveyance or other assurance as may be necessary to vest in the Crown as a public highway, ALL AND SINGULAR those certain parcels or tracts of lands and premises situate, lying and being in the City of Surrey, in the Province of British Columbia:

Those portions of Parcel Identifier 010-515-739 South 240 Feet Lot 6 Except: Parcel "B" (Explanatory Plan 12090) North West Quarter Section 29 Township 2 New Westminster District, Plan 3270, shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Scott E. Netherton, B.C.L.S. on the 10th day of April, 2002, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of land containing 282 square metres and called Parcel "A"; and

(Portion of 8620 - 128 Street)

That portion of land containing 903 square metres and called Parcel "B"

(Portion of 8620 - 128 Street)

3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of 86 Avenue Between 128 Street and 130 Street Road Exchange By-law, 2002, No. 14716".


