BY-LAW NO. 11722

A by-law to stop up and close a Portion of  
58A Avenue West of King George  
Highway.

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. 58A Avenue, at a line commencing at the most northwesterly corner of Lot 34, Section 9, Township 2, New Westminster District, Plan 45077;

thence northerly on the northerly production of the westerly limit of the said Lot 34 to the southerly limit of Parcel "A" (N29801E) Lot 5, Section 9, Township 2, New Westminster District, Plan 4395;

(58A Avenue West of King George Highway)

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "58A Avenue Road Closing By-law, 1993, No. 11722."

PASSED THREE READINGS by the Municipal Council on the 1st day of March, 1993.
