BY-LAW NO. 13131

A by-law to stop up and close a Lane  
North of 94A Avenue Between 127A  
Street and 128 Street.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 578 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 290, R.S.B.C., may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Lane North of 94A Avenue between 127A Street and 128 Street, at a line commencing at a point on the southerly boundary of Lot Twenty-Three (23), Section Thirty-One (31), Township Two (2), New Westminster District, Plan Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Four (20924), said point being 20.000 metres easterly from the southwesterly corner of the said Lot Twenty-Three (23);

Thence southerly on the said line to a point on the northerly boundary of Lot Twenty-Four (24), Section Thirty-One (31), Township Two (2), New Westminster District, Plan Twenty Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Four (20924), said point being 20.000 metres easterly from the northwesterly corner of the said Lot Twenty-Four (24),

Said line shown heavy dashed on sketch attached hereto and forming part of the By-law

(Lane North of 94A Avenue Between 127A Street and 128 Street)

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Lane North of 94A Avenue Between 127A Street and 128 Street Road Closing By-law, 1997, No. 13131."

PASSED THREE READINGS on the 26th day of May, 1997.
