BY-LAW NO. 13132

A by-law to stop up and close a Lane at
5900 Block Between Angus Place and 172
Street.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 578 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 290, R.S.B.C., may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Lane at the 5900 Block, between Angus Place and 172 Street, at a line commencing at the southeasterly corner of Lot Two Hundred Twenty-Nine (229), Section Seven (7), Township Eight (8), New Westminster District, Plan Sixty-Three Thousand One Hundred Sixty-Nine (63169);

Thence easterly on said line to the southwesterly corner of Lot 'D', Section Seven (7), Township Eight (8), New Westminster District, Plan Twenty Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty (20880),

Said line shown heavy dashed on sketch attached hereto and forming part of the By-law

(Lane at 5900 Block Between Angus Place and 172 Street)

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Lane at 5900 Block Between Angus Place and 172 Street Road Closing By-law, 1997, No. 13132."
