BY-LAW NO. 13543

A by-law to stop up and close a Portion of
Harvie Road Between 188 and 189 Streets
South of 96 Avenue.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 541 of the Municipal Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That portion of Parcel Identifier: 013-259-288, Parcel F (Reference Plan 4469) Except Parcel A (Bylaw Plan LMP27323) of the Northeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 8, New Westminster District as shown within the bold outline on a Reference Plan prepared by L. Achtemichuk, B.C.L.S. dated the 16th day of July 1998 having an area of 0.400 hectares and called Parcel "A", a copy of said reference plan attached hereto and forming a part of this By-law.

(Portion of Harvie Road between 188 Street and 189 Street South of 96 Avenue)

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of Harvie Road Between 188 and 189 Streets South of 96 Avenue Road Closing By-law, 1998, No. 13543."
