BY-LAW NO. 13790

A by-law to stop up and close a portion of lane south of 82A Avenue between 144A Street and 145A Street.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 541 of the Municipal Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. All that portion of Section 27 Township 2 New Westminster District shown dedicated on Plan 20956 and shown in heavy bold outline on a Reference Plan attached hereto and forming a part of this By-law prepared by Grant Butler, B.C.L.S., on the 25th day of May, 1999, containing 138 square metres and called Parcel "A" is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

(Portion of Lane South of 82A Avenue Between 144A Street and 145A Street)

2. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Portion of Lane South of 82A Avenue Between 144A Street and 145A Street Road Closing By-law, 1999, No. 13790."
