BY-LAW NO. 14119

A by-law to stop up and close a portion of Harvie Road from 189 Street to 190 Street.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 527(1) of the <i>Local Government</i>
Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any
portion of a highway;
NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS
FOLLOWS:
1. All that portion of Parcel F (Reference Plan 4469) North East Quarter Section 33 Township 8 New Westminster District Except Firstly: Parcel A (Bylaw Plan LMP27323); Secondly: Parcel A (Bylaw Plan LMP46883); Thirdly: Parcel Two (Bylaw Plan LMP46914); Fourthly: Parcel A (Bylaw Plan LMP) originally referred to in City of Surrey By-law 196 and filed in the Land Title Office under filing number 10537 and shown outlined in bold on a Reference Plan prepared by L. Achtemichuk, B.C.L.S. on the 18 th day of August, 2000 containing 0.403 hectares and called Parcel "B":
(Portion of Harvie Road between 189 Street and 190 Street)
is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
2. This By-law may be cited as "Surrey Stop Up and Close of Harvie Road between 189 Street and 190 Street By-law, 2000, No. 14119".
