BY-LAW NO. 14643

A by-law to stop up and close a portion of  
King George Highway at 32 Avenue Diversion.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 527(1) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, may by by-law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Portion of Road Lying in Section 22 Township 1 New Westminster District shown in heavy outline on a Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Montgomery C. Brisson, B.C.L.S., on the 7th day of January, 2002, dedicated by Right of Way Plan 5388, containing 256 square metres and more particularly described as follows:

(Portion of King George Highway at 32 Avenue Diversion)

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By-law may be cited as "Surrey Stop Up and Close of a Portion of King George Highway at 32 Avenue Diversion By-law, 2002, No. 14643."

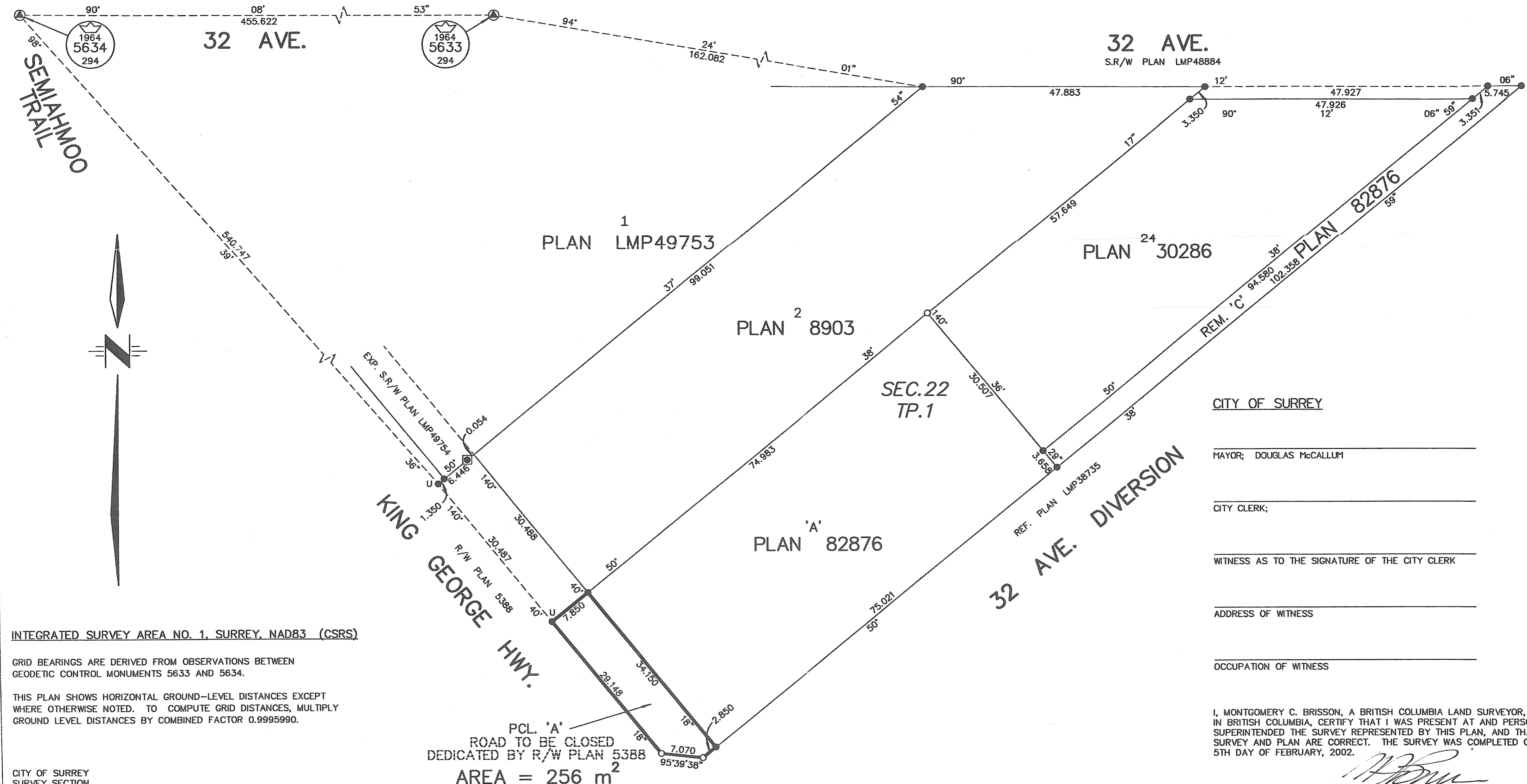
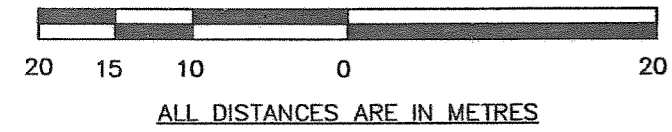
