

CITY OF SURREY

BY LAW NO. 14974

A by law to stop up and close a portion of
180 Street north of Fraser Highway.

.....

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Surrey, pursuant to Section 527(1) of the *Local Government Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c.323, as amended, may by by law, stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion of a highway;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Surrey, in open meeting assembled, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. 180 Street, at a line commencing at a point on the westerly boundary of Lot Thirty-Seven (37) Section Seventeen (17) Township Eight (8) New Westminster District Plan Thirty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Forty-One (34641) said point being 43 metres southerly from the northwesterly corner of said Lot 37;

Thence westerly and perpendicular to said westerly boundary of Lot 37 on said line to intersection with the easterly boundary of Parcel 'One' (T76282E) of Parcel 'C' (Reference Plan Four Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Two (4462)) Northwest Quarter Section Seventeen (17) Township Eight (8) New Westminster District;

Said line shown heavy dashed on sketch attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.

(Portion of 180 Street north of Fraser Highway);

is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.

2. This By law may be cited as "Stop Up and Close of a Portion of 180 Street North of Fraser Highway By law, 2003, No. 14974".
