

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 15450

A By law to close and to remove the dedication  
of a highway of a portion of Road at 61 Avenue and 168 Street.

.....

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 7, Township 8, New Westminster District, shown outlined in heavy bold outline on a Reference Plan, attached hereto and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Gary C. Sundvick, B.C.L.S. on the 19th day of April, 2004, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road dedicated by Plan LMP29624, containing  
45 square metres and called Parcel "A"

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of road)

shall be closed to traffic.

2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of road.
3. This By law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Road at 61 Avenue and 168 Street By-law, 2004, No. 15450".

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME on the 19th day of July, 2004.

NOTICE OF INTENTION

ADVERTISED on the 24th and 25th day of July and on the 31st day of July and 1st day of August, 2004, in the SURREY LEADER/PEACE ARCH Community newspaper.
