CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 15588

A By law to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of a portion of 164 Street at Bell Road.

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 12, Township 2, New Westminster District, shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto, and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by G.A. Hol, B.C.L.S. on the 12th day of June, 2004, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road dedicated on Plan 1752, containing 0.307 hectares and called Parcel 1,

(Portion of 164 Street)

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of 164 Street)

shall be closed to traffic.

- 2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of 164 Street.
- 3. This By law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of 164 Street at Bell Road By-law, 2004, No. 15588".

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME on the 6th day of December, 2004.

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ADVERTISED on the 11th and 12th day of December and on the 18th and 19th day of December, 2004, in the SURREY LEADER/PEACE ARCH Community newspaper.
