## CITY OF SURREY

## BY-LAW NO. 15911

A By-law to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of a portion of 82A Avenue.

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by-law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 28 Township 2 New Westminster District, shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto, and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by J.G. Cameron, B.C.L.S. on the 20th day of December, 2004, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road dedicated on Plan 48828, called Parcel "A" and containing 0.162 hectares,

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of 82A Avenue)

shall be closed to traffic.

- 2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of 82A Avenue.
- 3. "Portion of 82A Avenue at 140 Street Road Exchange By-law, 2003, No. 15058" is hereby repealed.
- 4. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of 82A Avenue at 140 Street By-law, 2006, No. 15911".

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME on the 16th day of January, 2006.
