A By-law to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of a portion of 76 Avenue.

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by-law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 21 Township 2 New Westminster District, shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto, and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Gene Paul Nikula, B.C.L.S. on the 27th day of July, 2006, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road dedicated by Plan 5533, containing 231.4 square metres and called Parcel "A",
(hereinafter referred to as that portion of 76 Avenue)
shall be closed to traffic.
2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of 76 Avenue.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of 76 Avenue at 144 Street By-law, 2006, No. 16078".

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME on the 11th day of September, 2006.
