

CITY OF SURREY

BY-LAW NO. 17211

A By-law to close and to remove the dedication
of a highway of a portion of road.
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WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by-law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey in open meeting assembled, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 9, Block 5, North Range 2 West, New Westminster District shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan attached hereto, and forming part of this by-law, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Gene Paul Nikula, B.C.L.S. on the 22nd day of June, 2010, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of road dedicated by Plan 480, called Parcel "A" and containing 0.197 hectares,

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)

shall be closed to traffic.

2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portions of Road.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as " Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of 113A Avenue and 131 Street By-Law, 2010, No. 17211".

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME on the 12th day of July, 2010.

NOTICE OF INTENTION

ADVERTISED on the 16th day of July, 2010 in the SURREY NOW, and on the 16th and 23rd day of July, 2010, in the PEACH ARCH NEWS AND SURREY LEADER newspapers.
