BY-LAW NO. 17955

A By-law to close and to remove the dedication
of a highway of a portion of road
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WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by by-law, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a by-law under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of Section 9 Block 5 North, Range 2 West, New Westminster District dedicated as Road and shown outlined in heavy black line on Reference Plan attached hereto, duly signed by the Mayor and Clerk, prepared by Scott E. Netherton, BCLS, on the 9th day of May, 2012 and described as follows:

That portion of Road dedicated by Plan 480, Plan 5719 and Plan BCP 52064, called Parcel 'A' containing 0.322 hectares; and

That portion of Road dedicated by Plan 480, Plan 5719 and Plan BCP 52064, called Parcel 'B' and containing 0.356 hectares.

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)

shall be closed to traffic.

2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road.
3. This By-law may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Road Adjacent to King George Boulevard Between 130 Street and 132 Street By-law, 2013, No. 17955"




PASSED SECOND READING on the 17th day of June, 2013.
