BYLAW NO. 18016

A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of a portion of road

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey, ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road on Plan 1832 Block 13 Section 22 Block 5 North Range 1 New Westminster District dedicated as Road and shown outlined in heavy black line on Reference Plan EPP32655 attached hereto, prepared by Lakhjot Grewal, BCLS, on the 10th day of July, 2013 and described as follows:

That portion of Road dedicated by Plan 1832 and Plan EPP32655 containing 126.1 square metres

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road) shall be closed to traffic.

- 2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road.
- 3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Road Adjacent to 10615 160 Street, Bylaw, 2013, No. 18016"
