A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of portions of

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

That portion of road in Section 33 Township 8 New Westminster District dedicated by 1. Plan 614 shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan EPP46324 attached hereto, prepared by John Onderwater, B.C.L.S, on the 31st day of October, 2014, and described as follows:

That portion of Road called Parcel A containing 235.0 square metres.

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of road)

shall be closed to traffic.

- The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of road. 2.
- This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of 3. Highway of a Portion of Road Adjacent to 19049 - 95A Avenue, Bylaw, 2014, No. 18323"
