BYLAW NO. 18474

A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication
of a highway of portions of road
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WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of District Lot 6 Group 2 New Westminster District Dedicated by Plan 1952 shown outlined on Reference Plan EPP51308 attached hereto, prepared by Mike Bernemann, B.C.L.S. on the 29th day of June, 2015, and described as follows:

that portion of road containing 0.233 hectares and labeled Parcel 'A';

shall be closed to traffic.

2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road.
3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Road Adjacent to 10805, 10815, 10821, 10825, 10833 and 10845 Timberland Road and 10848 Faulkner Road Bylaw, 2015, No. 18474".




PASSED SECOND READING on the 27th day of July, 2015.
