BYLAW NO. 18785

A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of portions of road

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Those portions of Section 27 Block 5 North Range 2 West New Westminster District Dedicated by Plan 24998 shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan EPP61718 attached hereto, prepared by Montgomery C. Brisson, B.C.L.S. on the 13th day of July, 2016, and described as follows:
 - a. that portion of road containing 205.6 square metres and labelled Parcel A;
 - b. that portion of road containing 104.8 square metres and labelled Parcel B; and (hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)

shall be closed to traffic.

- 2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road.
- 3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Road Adjacent to 10346 132 Street, 10357 133 Street, 13216 104 Avenue and 13226 104 Avenue Bylaw, 2016, No. 18785".
