## BYLAW NO. 18897

A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of portions of road 

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

- Those portions of Section 22 and 27 Township 2 New Westminster District dedicated by 1. Statutory Right of Way Plan EPP55565 and Plan 11774 shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan EPP60619 attached hereto, prepared by Gary Sundvick, B.C.L.S. on the 11th day of October, 2016, and described as follows:
  - that portion of road containing 799.5 square metres and labelled Parcel A; a.
  - b. that portion of road containing 742.6 square metres and labelled Parcel B; and (hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)

shall be closed to traffic.

- The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road. 2.
- This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of 3. Highway of a Portion of Road Adjacent to 7929, 8009 and 8055 - 152 Street Bylaw, 2016, No. 18897".
