## CITY OF SURREY

BYLAW NO. 19281
A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of portions of road

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40 (1)(a) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 4o(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of Section 25 Block 5 North Range 1 West, New Westminster District dedicated by Plan LMP 57092 shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan EPP 69704 attached hereto, prepared by Sean Costello, B.C.L.S. on the 12 th day of June, 2017, and described as follows:
that portion of road containing 142.1 square metres and labeled Parcel " A "; (hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)
shall be closed to traffic.
2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road.
3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Road Adjacent to 16668-103 Avenue Bylaw, 2017, No. 19281".
