BYLAW NO. 19456

A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of portions of lane

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of Section 35 Township 2 New Westminster District dedicated by Reference Plans BCP2029 and EPP64678 shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan EPP 66627 attached hereto, prepared by Johnson C. Tam, B.C.L.S. on the 12th day of January, 2017, and described as follows:

that portion of lane containing 612.3 square metres and labeled as "Lane to be Closed";

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of Lane)

shall be closed to traffic.

- 2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Lane.
- 3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of a Portion of Lane Adjacent to 15405 and 15377 88 Avenue and 15398 and 15420 Fraser Highway Bylaw, 2018, No. 19456".
