BYLAW NO. 19833

A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication of a highway of portion of road

WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the Community Charter, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

That portion of Section 9 Township 2 New Westminster District shown outlined in heavy 1. black line on Reference Plan EPP 90118 attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, prepared by Lorin Levac, B.C.L.S. on the 18th day of June, 2019, and described as follows:

> that portion of unconstructed road allowance dedicated by Subdivision Plan 2163 and Subdivision Plan 2840 containing 0.330 hectares and labeled as "A";

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)

shall be closed to traffic.

- The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road. 2.
- This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of 3. Highway of a Portion of Road adjacent to 6173 and 6299 - 144 Street Bylaw, 2019, No. 19833".
