BYLAW NO. 20552

A Bylaw to close and to remove the dedication  
of a highway of portion of Road  
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WHEREAS pursuant to Subsection 40(1)(a) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, close all or part of a highway that is vested in the municipality to all or some types of traffic;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 40(2) of the *Community Charter*, S.B.C. 2003, c. 26, the Council may, by bylaw, remove the dedication of a highway that has been closed by a bylaw under Subsection 40(1)(a).

NOW, THEREFORE the Council of the City of Surrey ENACTS as follows:

1. That portion of road lying in Section 15, Block 5 North, Range 2 West, NWD Plan BCP48711 shown outlined in heavy black line on a Reference Plan EPP116818 attached hereto, prepared by Gregory Marston, B.C.L.S. on the 23rd day of November, 2021, and described as follows:

That portion of Road labeled PCL A containing 0.184 hectares.

(hereinafter referred to as that portion of Road)

shall be closed to traffic.

2. The dedication as highway be removed of said portion of Road.
3. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Surrey Close and Remove the Dedication of Highway of Portion of Road Adjacent to 13335 King George Boulevard and 13377 Barker Street Bylaw, 2022, No. 20552".



