River Conveyance Works (2004)**

RECOMMENDATION

That Contract M.S. 4802-004-31 be awarded to the low bidder, Double M Excavating Ltd., in the amount of \$1,848,516.10 including GST.

SCOPE OF WORK

Contract M.S. 4802-004-31 is the third year of flood control works in Inter-River areas. The work will include upgrading existing ditches, constructing new ditches and installing culverts along 48 Avenue, from 152 Street to 158 block, and 152 Street between Serpentine River and 40 Avenue.

Construction is expected to start by early May 2004 and be completed by September 30, 2004.

TENDER RESULTS

Tenderers in this project were by invitation only. They are contractors from the Council-approved pre-qualified list for this type of work.

Tenderers for the above contract were received on April 14, 2004, with the results as follows:

The Engineer's pre-tender estimate was \$1,680,565.54 including GST.

EVALUATION

All quotations were checked for legal or mathematical errors. There was only one minor mathematical error; however, it did not alter the overall standings. Double M Excavating Ltd. is the low bidder and their past

performance with the City on similar work has been very good.
